Presenters:

Christine Kettunen Ph.D., R.N., CIC is the Director of Nursing & Health Education for the Ashtabula County Health Department. She plans, organizes and directs all activities of the nursing and health education department. She monitors trends in the community and plans new and adjusts existing programs as needed. Christine works with community partners on committees and taskforces to develop and implement programs to improve the health of the population. Ashtabula County is home to over 500 Amish. They have been settling in the area for over 30 years. Christine has consulted and has insight into the health needs of this population.

Marilyn Weitzel PH. D., R.N. CNE has been a nursing educator teaching in various types of programs. She was the Director of the Graduate Program at Cleveland State University. This program had a track in forensic nursing. This specialty prepares nurses to work in prisons, jails, attorney offices, insurance companies and other places where the law and nursing intersect. She has studied criminology and is a member of a correctional nursing group. Dr. Weitzel participates in the Bill Glass ministry, Behind the Walls, presenting the gospel to inmates in Ohio prisons.

Malinda Winters, RN, MSN, FNP-BC is a nurse practitioner for the Hattie Larlham Center for Children with Disabilities (HLCCD). As a nurse practitioner, she has collaborated with the medical director, director of nursing and other medical staff to ensure that effective medical plans are in place for each person for most of her career. Malinda has worked in the field of children's healthcare in a variety of hospital settings, including as a clinical nurse in a neonate intensive care unit and in a neurology department. She is board certified as a family nurse practitioner from the American Nurses Credentialing Center and is a member of American Association of Nurse Practitioners and Ohio Association of Advance Practice.
