March 2024 Prayer and Praise Calendar

Week One:

- March 2 – Pray for wisdom, discernment, and encouragement for Kathy Schoonover-Shoffner as she balances numerous responsibilities within Nurses Christian Fellowship and the *Journal of Christian Nursing*.

Week Two:

- March 3 – We thank God for the community that’s a part of our nurse groups. Pray for our nurse groups to continue to be safe places for students, faculty, and nurses. We lift up our [Sunday night prayer group times](#) and ask God to use this time to draw us into deeper intimacy with you, God.
